Ambassador Jayantha Dhanapala’s distinguished career has spanned the private sector, government, the United Nations and academia. He was the acclaimed President of the Nuclear Non-Proliferation Treaty Review and Extension Conference in 1995. In the UN, he has served as Director of the Institute for Disarmament Research and as Under Secretary General to re-establish the Department of Disarmament. He is a member of international groups including the International Weapons of Mass Destruction Committee, the Governing Board of the Stockholm International Peace Research Institute and the Geneva Centre for the Democratic Control of Armed Forces. In 2007, Ambassador Dhanapala was unanimously elected President of the Pugwash Conferences on Science and World Affairs.
